1st IBFRA Insight Topic:

Sustainable boreal forest management

- challenges and opportunities for climate change mitigation -

It will address climate change impacts, role of forests in mitigating climate change and the ways in which the forest sector can contribute to net negative emissions.

Kick-Off at Skogens Dag 2019, 23 January, Stockholm, Sweden

Funding under the framework of the National Swedish Forest Programme:

To strengthen strategic collaboration on boreal forests in science-policy interface Collaboration: Swedish Forest Agency, Future Forests at SLU, IBFRA. The project funding from both SFA and SLU.

Commissioned upon a request dated 2018-06-26 by ministers for forests and their high-level representatives from Canada, Finland, Norway, Sweden, the Russian Federation and the United States of America to enhance science-policy linkages and knowledge exchange on circumboreal issues.

IBFRA Insight Process – STATUS-QUO?

- → Version submitted for independent review to IBFRA secretariate April 2021: 27 international coauthors/experts from US, Canada, Norway, Sweden, Finland, Russia, Int.Org. (IIASA)
- → Sent out for review April 2021
- → 8 independent reviews received from experts from US/CAN/Sweden/Finland/Russia in May 2021
- → Review comments provided to Author(s) May 2021
- → First revised version by first author P. Högberg circulated to all authors June 2021
- → scientific consensus by all co-authors by August 2021
- → 1st public presentation on the report at the IBFRA 2021 Conference 16-20 August 2021
- → Providing the report to ToS for feedback on policy issues wrt the report findings by end of August 2021
- → Entering editorial processes with publishing entity/-house
- → Online/hard copy launch tbd
- → Follow-up scientific publications deriving from the report
