

**EXTENSION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN
THE UNITED NATIONS ECONOMIC COMMISSION FOR EUROPE
AND
THE GLASGOW URBAN LABORATORY AT THE GLASGOW SCHOOL OF
ART**

WHEREAS, the Glasgow School of Art, and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (hereinafter “UNECE”), a regional commission of the United Nations, have concluded a Memorandum of Understanding (“Memorandum as a statement of intent by the Glasgow School of Art and UNECE to develop cooperation for the understanding and promotion of sustainable cities through the establishment of a Geneva UN Charter Centre of Excellence on Smart Sustainable Cities (Center of Excellence) based at the Glasgow Urban Laboratory, Glasgow School of Art) for the implementation of the Geneva United Nations Charter on Sustainable Housing;

WHEREAS, the original MoU was signed on 8 November 2017 and came into force and effect on that date until 7 November 2020;

WHEREAS, under paragraph 12, of the original MoU, such original MoU may be extended in writing for subsequent period of three years;

WHEREAS, the Glasgow School of Art, expresses its wish to extend the original MoU for another three years (see Annex 1 - Letter dated 28 June 2021 from Mr. Brian Evans to Ms. Olga Algayerova); and

WHEREAS, UNECE, agrees to extend the original MoU for a further period of three years;

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with paragraph 12, UNECE and the Glasgow School of Art hereby agree that the original MoU shall be extended for a period of three years, until 28 June 2024.
