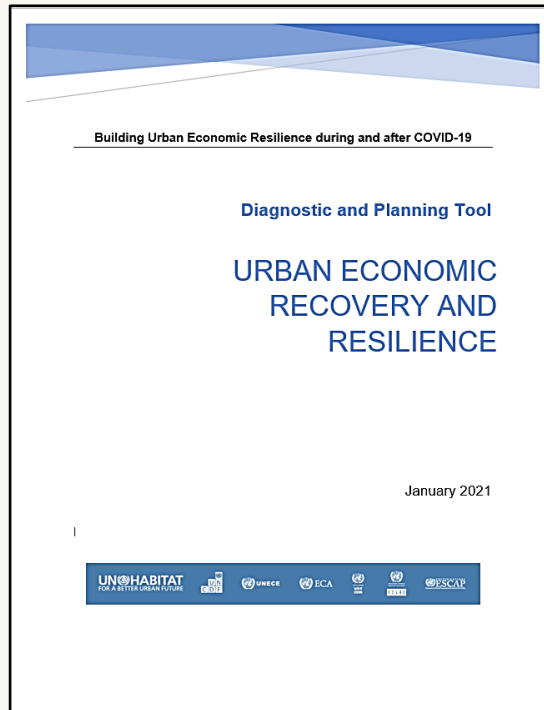

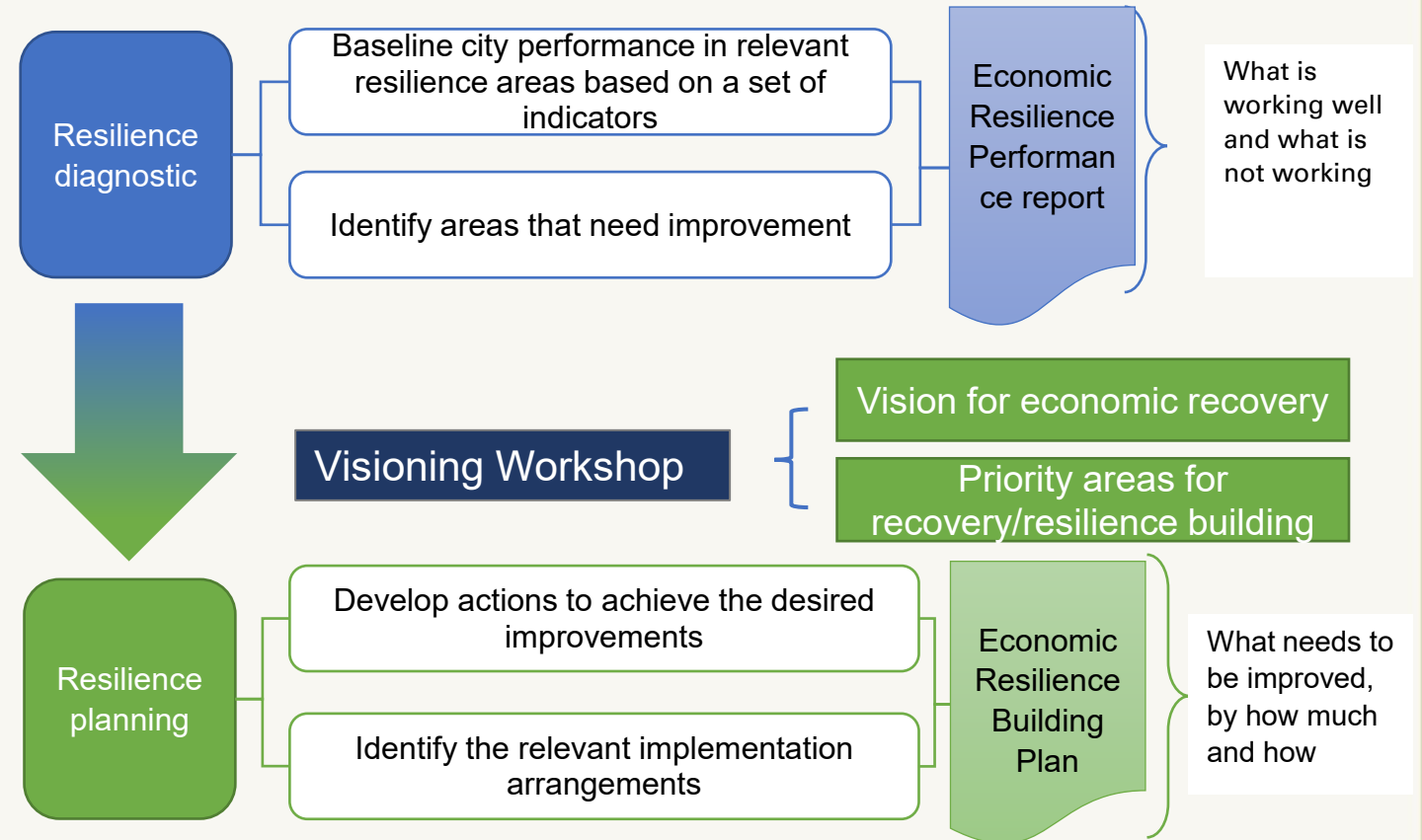

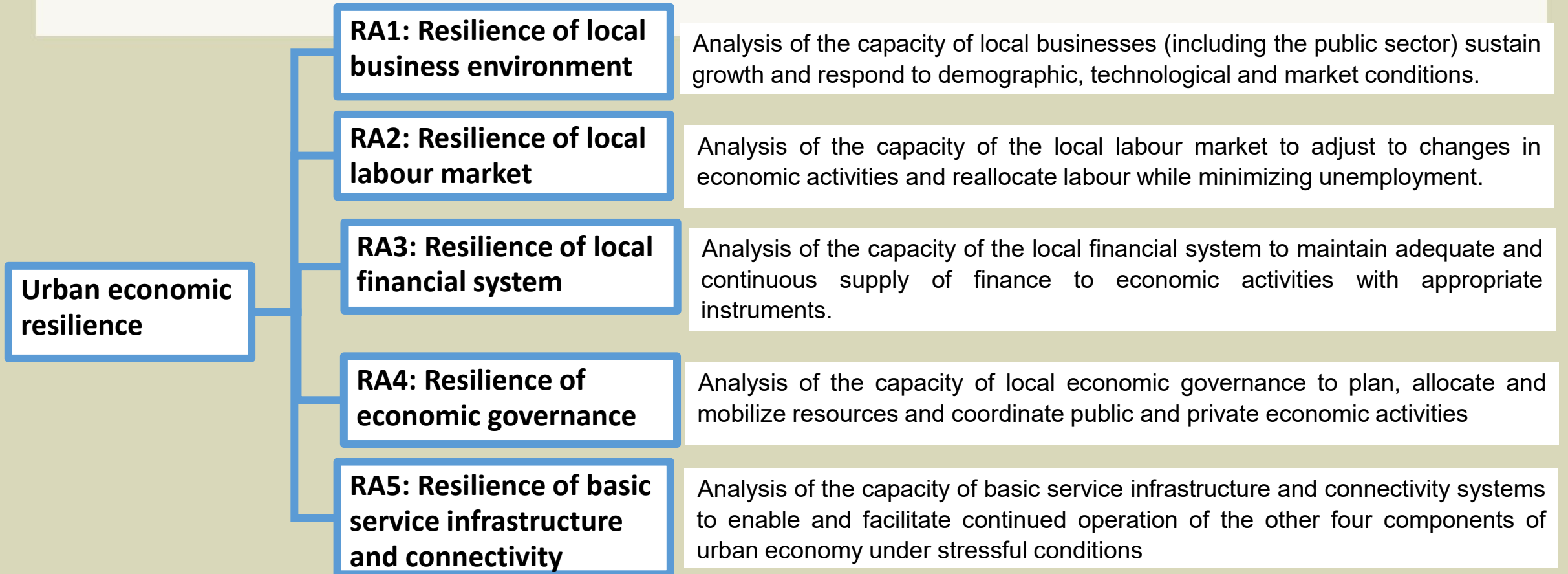
Urban Resilience Diagnostic Tool

B. Inform planning activities to achieve desired improvements to identified areas



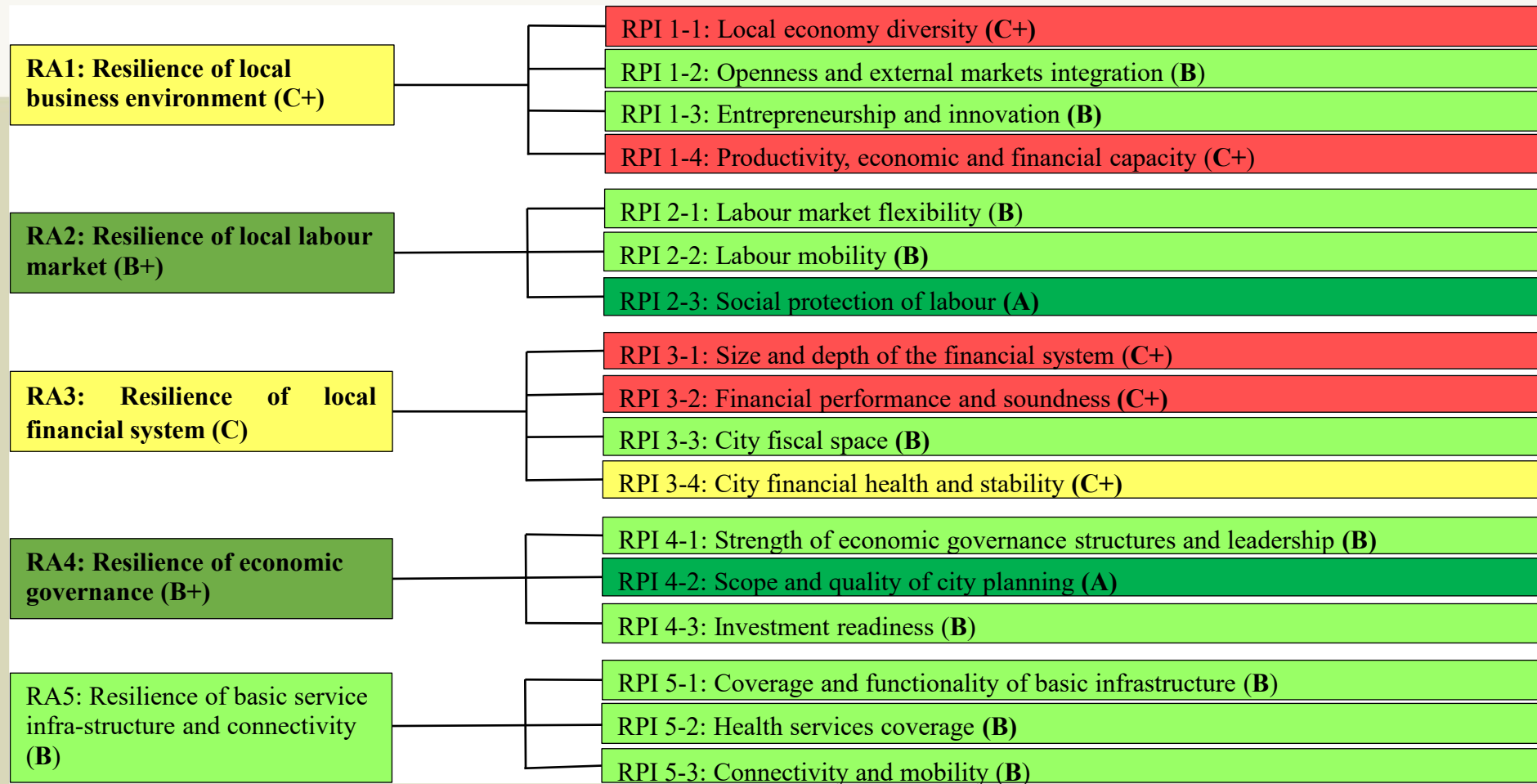

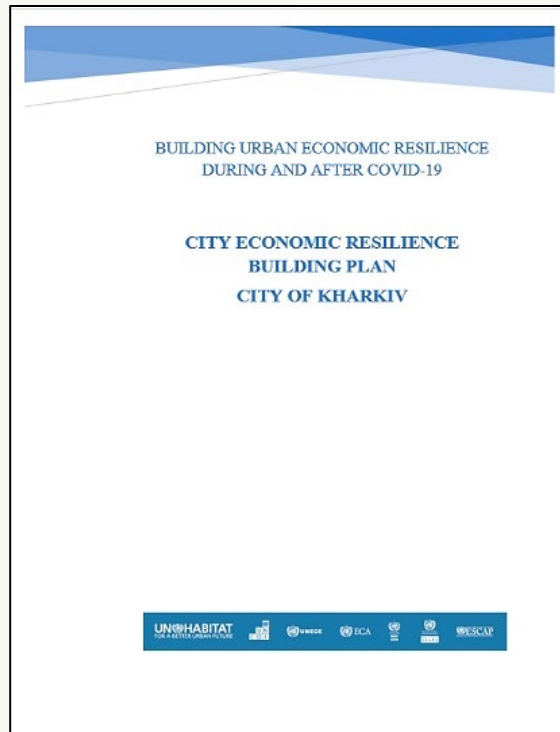
The overall Score
