

Proposal for Supplement 2 to the 03 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 118 (Burning behaviour of materials)

Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions *

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions at its 121st session, held in April 2021 (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/100, para. 28). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2021/3 as complemented by GRSG-121-04. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and the Administrative Committee of the 1958 Agreement (AC.1) for consideration and vote at their November 2021 sessions.

The present document is submitted in conformity with that mandate.





Insert a new paragraph 1.1.1., to read:

"1.1.1. At the request of the manufacturer, this Regulation may also apply to vehicles of Categories M3, Class I."

Part II, insert a new paragraph 6.1.9., to read:

"6.1.9. "Plastic glazing" is a glazing material that contains as an essential ingredient one or more organic polymeric substances of large molecular weight, is solid in its finished state and, at some stage in its manufacture of processing into finished articles, can be shaped by flow."

Part II, paragraph 6.2.8.1., amend to read:

"6.2.8.1. Parts made of metal or glass; Parts made of plastic glazing are not included in this exemption."
