

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its eighty-fourth session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/84, para. 20). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2020/17. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their November 2021 sessions.

"The sheets of the relevant LED light source category and the group in which this category is listed with restrictions on the use of this category shall apply as incorporated in Resolution R.E.5 or its subsequent revisions, applicable at the time of application for type approval of the LED light source; however, the sheets of LED replacement light sources are excluded from this Annex 1."
