### Looking Forward



• The Guidelines will be tested in several cities, including **Evian** in France, **Bishkek** in Kyrgyzstan, as well as several Ukrainian cities and others.



• UNECE will also engage with the city of **Madrid** in Spain, in developing the "KPI+" set of indicators to support the development of VLRs.



• Additionally, we are setting up an online portal with e-learning materials and organizing 3 sub-regional workshops in 2021, as well as a side event to the FoM 2022 on VLRs.





## UN Forum of Mayors

The first Forum of Mayors in October 2020 brought together 40 Mayors and Vice-Mayors, representing 36 countries to amplify local solutions and to discuss how they were overcoming the challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic in their cities.
