

Car sharing and carpooling

UNECE

- To strengthen the capacity of Central Asian countries to develop a sustainable urban mobility policy on car sharing and carpooling initiatives.
- Study prepared on car sharing and carpooling initiatives.
- Workshop held on 8 October dedicated to urban mobility, car sharing and carpooling in Central Asia.
- Pilot projects in 2022 to focus on Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan.



Transport, Health and Environment Pan-European Programme 5th High-Level Meeting (1)



- THE PEP is a unique intergovernmental, cross-sectoral policy platform for policymakers and stakeholders of the countries of the pan-European region for accelerating the transformation towards clean, safe and healthy mobility and net-zero-emission transport.
- The High-Level Meeting (17-18 May):
 - Over 850 participants
 - 46 Ministers and State secretaries from 42 countries in the ECE Region
 - Participants adopted the Vienna Declaration to spur the transformation towards clean, safe, healthy and inclusive transport and mobility, with a strong focus on promoting cycling across the region



Transport, Health and Environment Pan-European Programme 5th High-Level Meeting (2)



THE Vienna Declaration

- A comprehensive pan-European strategy for transforming mobility.
- Focus on moving towards zero emissions, health-promoting mobility, safe and efficient transport
- Strong emphasis on cycling and walking and promoting their safety.
- Putting equality and accessibility at the centre of policy making.

The Pan-European Master Plan for Cycling Promotion



Objectives for 2030

- Double cycling in the region increase in all countries
- Increase the safety of cyclists and halve the rate of fatalities and serious injuries
- Reallocating space for cycling and walking;
- Improve the active mobility infrastructure;
- Increase cyclist and pedestrian safety;
- Develop national cycling policies, strategies & plans;
- Integrate cycling into health policies, infrastructure, land use, urban and regional planning






Permanent Identification of Railway Rolling Stock

- Capture traffic from other modes










- Facilitating international rail transport of goods and containers on the basis of a single contract of carriage










