- SDG Indicators: 1.1.1, 1.2.1, 1.2.2, 1.3.1, 1.4.1, 10.1.1, 10.2.1
- Availability by various disaggregation
- Data coverage and latest available period
- Review based on data reported to Global SDG Database (as of 12 November 2021)








1.1.1 – Proportion of population below international poverty line

Data coverage (Y2009-Y2020) and latest available year








1.1.1 - Employed population below international poverty line

Employed population below international poverty line, both sexes, age 25+ (%)








1.2.1 – Population living below national poverty line












10.2.1 - Proportion of people living below 50 per cent of median income

Conclusion

- 1.1.1 International poverty line
 - Good coverage in 8 countries out of 12
 - Improvement in the coverage for employed population: in 11 countries out of 12
- 1.3.1 Population covered by social protection floors/systems
 - Improved availability of sex-disaggregated data
- No change observed for indicators 1.2.1, 1.4.1, 10.1.1, 10.2.1
- Major updates to Global SDG Database expected in December 2021
