

2. Work on the Globally Harmonized System (GHS)

(a) Work of the Sub-Committee of Experts on the Transport of Dangerous Goods (TDG) on matters of interest to the GHS Sub-Committee

(c) Use of non-animal testing methods for classification of health hazards

The experts from the United Kingdom and the Netherlands may wish to inform the Sub-Committee about the progress on the work on this topic since the fortieth session (see ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/80, paras. 13 to 17).

(d) Classification of skin sensitizers using the results of local lymph node assays (LLNA) test methods in accordance with OECD Test Guideline 442B

Informal document INF.6 (Japan) Clarification of the criteria for classification for skin sensitization using animal studies

(e) Classification criteria for germ cell mutagenicity

3. Implementation of the GHS

(a) Possible development of a list of chemicals classified in accordance with the GHS

The experts from Canada and the United States of America may wish to inform the Sub-Committee about the progress on the work on this topic since the fortieth session (see ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/80, paras. 41 to 43).

(b) Reports on the status of implementation

GHS Sub-Committee participants will be invited to provide information about progress with GHS implementation (including challenges faced, lessons learnt, impact) in their countries or areas of work.

The Sub-Committee will receive an update on the implementation of the European Union chemical's strategy for sustainability as a follow-up to the information provided at the fortieth session (see ST/SG/AC.10/C.4/80, paras. 55 to 60).

(c) Cooperation with other bodies or international organizations

It is expected that the representatives of the Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) and the World Health Organization (WHO) provide an update to the Sub-Committee on progress with GHS implementation through legal instruments, recommendations or guidelines under their responsibility.

Other bodies and international organisations may also wish to inform the Sub-Committee about recent developments on GHS implementation within their areas of work.
