Preliminary findings

- Virtually all reports received were prepared using a participatory approach
- Several countries reported recognising population ageing as a major policy issue
- Elements of a mainstreaming ageing approach were discernible in the national policies of most countries
- Countries reported on the strong impact of the COVID-19 crisis on older persons, highlighting both positive and negative implications



Preliminary findings

Main achievements reported by countries:

- Rising life expectancy
- Advances in healthy ageing
- Increased focus on the human rights of older persons
- More flexible pension systems
- Extension of working lives
- More available digital services
- Advances in ageing in place
- Mainstreaming ageing across policy fields and levels of governance

Main challenges and needs reported by countries:

- Lack of sufficient social care, long-term care and community-based care services
- Gaps in coordinated and integrated care
- Health inequities
- Shortage of social and health care professionals
- Economic and social sustainability of pension systems
- Shortage of affordable housing
- Digital exclusion
