- 5. Employment rate by age group
- 6. Unemployment rate by age group

Social participation indicators:

- 7a. Volunteering and political participation
 - engaging in volunteering
 - > involved in political and civic life
- 7b. Provision of informal care
 - providing care to children, grandchildren
 - providing care to older or disabled relatives

Independent, healthy and secure living indicators:

8a. Physical activity and access to health services

- taking part in sports or physical exercise
- no unmet need for medical and dental examination or treatment
- 8b. Financial security
 - > ratio of the median income of persons aged 65 and above to that of persons aged below 65
 - > not at a risk of poverty
 - not severely materially deprived

8c. Independent living arrangements, physical safety and lifelong learning

- living in a single-person or a couple household
- > feeling safe in local area
- Involvement in training or education
