# Monitoring, Assessment and Reporting (1)

#### **Projects (donors) – expiration date**

 Accountability systems for sustainable forest management in the Caucasus and Central Asia (UN Development Account) – December 2020

- Five countries (Armenia, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Uzbekistan) developed national sets of Criteria and Indicators (C&I) for sustainable forest management
- Increased knowledge and national capacity in developing forest management tools and communication participatory methods
  - Guidelines for the Development of a C&I Set for SFM
  - Five policy briefs on application of C&I in SFM
- Revitalized subregional (CCA) international forest-related cooperation and exchange
  - Forest Congress for the Caucasus and Central Asia (2018)

- Improved information and understanding of how COVID-19 affected production and consumption of wood products in the UNECE region in 2020.







### **Boreal Forests**

- Improved awareness about the importance of boreal forests for climate action and sustainable development (more than 10,000 people engaged on social media)
- Improved collaboration with boreal-related research organizations (e.g. participation and engagement in the IBFRA Insight process)
- Strengthened science-policy cooperation more than 30 science and policy experts gathered to discuss boreal-related challenges and opportunities for collaboration.







### Sustainable Urban and Peri-Urban Forestry

- Increased commitment cities from 25 countries have committed to plant over 10 million trees in cities
- Creation of a community of practice on sustainable urban forestry through an informal network of experts.







### **Forest Landscape Restoration**
