- The Congress is held every 6 years
- Government of Republic of South Korea as the host is organizing and financing the Congress
- FAO is in charge of the technical programme and planning of the related events
- Largest and most significant gathering of global forest sector
- Crucial timing as the world enters new era COVID-19, Decade of Action, Decade for Ecosystem Restoration, Post 2020 Biodiversity Framework
- Participation is open for all countries, regions and sectors, public and private organizations, and civil society


Contribution of forests to inclusive and sustainable national & global rebuilding efforts following the pandemic

- 6. Forests without boundaries: enhancing management and cooperation




## **Programme features**

## Voluntary contributions – Papers, posters and videos

- Calls for abstracts were announced in 2020 and 2021 for papers, posters and videos.
- 2 000+ abstracts and videos were submitted and reviewed by forestry experts.
- 1 400+ abstracts passed the abstract screening to submit full complete versions of papers or posters.
- Full submissions and videos are currently under review.
- Speakers will be selected from accepted contributions.

## **Youth Engagement**


- Led by Youth Outreach Liaison Consultant, together with WFC youth partners
