Proposal for Supplement 2 to the 01 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 39 (Speedometer and Odometer)

Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions *

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions (GRSG) at its 122nd session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/101, para. 56). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/2021/20/Rev.1. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their March 2022 sessions.

Following paragraph 5.5.1.; insert new paragraph 5.5.2., to read:

"5.5.2. The odometer shall display the distance in the unit corresponding to that of the predominant speedometer scale. If a setting makes it possible for the driver to select the odometer display distance in km or miles independently of the speedometer, the odometer shall identify the unit used."
