- FAO Global Forest Resource Assessment / Collaborative Forest Resources Questionnaire
- Joint UNECE/FAO/FOREST EUROPE 2025 data collection on forests and forest management in the pan-European region

Preparatory work

- Improvement of the reporting formats
- Development of the information system for the pan-European data collection
- FAO's Expert Consultation on Global Forest Resources Assessment (FRA), planned for September 2022

Process coordination

- Agreement by UNECE, FAO and FOREST EUROPE governing bodies on the joint 2025 the pan-European data collection
- Monthly coordination meetings of the three secretariats






Forest damage/disturbance assessment
