**Our mandate is to prepare the GGS wave 2 (follow up) questionnaire**

Following the consultations with the Consortium Board members, the main assumptions for our work on the wave 2 questionnaire:

**1. Focus on the GGP core: families, generations and gender.**

**Updating:**

- partnership and fertility histories
- information on children, fertility intentions, reproductive health
- information on contacts between generations, division of household tasks etc.
- information on respondent's (and partner's) activity in the labour market

**2. Keeping the rest as brief as possible**

**3. Simplifying the questionnaire (CAWI friendly)**

**4. Allowing space for user-suggested modules & questions**
