



### TRANSBOUNDARY WATERS: A KEY ASSET IN AFRICA

- Transboundary rivers, lakes and aquifers are vital for : drinking water, biodiversity, energy, agriculture, industry, fishing, waterway transport...
- Large-scale development projects may significantly affect water availability downstream
- Upstream water conservation is important to protect the entire system

- Opening of the Water Convention for its globalisation
- EU Green Deal included in the new programming

- Pan-African entities (AU inc. AMCOW, NEPAD, ANBO), Regional Economic Communities
- Transboundary Basin Authorities, with different needs

SO 4: Increase investments of transboundary relevance enabling economic development and regional integration


