Administrative Arrangement between the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) and European Commission (COM) services

This document provides the text of administrative arrangement between the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe, the Joint Research Centre, and the Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport of the European Commission which will (upon signing) allow the activities envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding between the European Commission services and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe of 2009, as last modified by the Administrative Arrangement of 9 February 2021, to continue for from 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2024.

## Administrative Arrangement between the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE) and European Commission (COM) services

The Joint Research Centre and the Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport of the European Commission, represented for the purpose of signing this Administrative Arrangement by Dan Chirondojan, Director of Directorate E – Space, Security & Migration of the Joint Research Centre, and by Kristian Schmidt, Director for Land Transport of the Directorate-General for Mobility and Transport, duly entitled to sign,

and

United Nations Economic Commission for Europe (UNECE), with the registered address at Palais des Nations, CH, 1211 Geneva 10, Switzerland, represented by Yuwei Li, Director, Sustainable Transport Division, duly entitled to sign,

hereafter referred to as 'the Sides'

Have come to the following mutual understanding:

Section 1

The activities envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding between the European Commission services and the United Nations Economic Commission for Europe of 2009, as last modified by the Administrative Arrangement of 9 February 2021, will continue for further 24 months, namely, from 1 January 2023 to 31 December 2024.
