




Figure 5: Population pyramids, EU27, 2008, 2060

How much are you concerned about the raising number of people 65 +?







Active ageing

- European Commission = "AA means helping people stay in charge of their own lives for as long as possible as they age and, where possible, to contribute to the economy and society."
- Active ageing refers to the situation where older and ageing persons continue to have an opportunity in participating in the formal labour market, as well as engaging in other unpaid productive activities, that may range from care provision for family members to volunteering, whilst living healthy, independent and secure lives as they age.









Perceived contribution of people 55+









The importance of ... in life – the Czech Republic - EVS




Importance of ... in life by age









