- Study Potential for improving energy efficiency in refrigeration and air-conditioning sector of Uzbekistan (in cooperation with UNDP) - completed
- Project Improving the energy efficiency of the global building supply chain industry and its products to deliver high performance buildings planned

    - Beneficiary countries in the UNECE region: Armenia, Kazakhstan, and Uzbekistan




#### **Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy**



  - Rebuilding the energy system in Ukraine under the carbon neutrality and just transition concepts

- Study on Analysis of the local geological and mining conditions and Development of technical, principle-based guidelines for efficient, safe, and environmentally conscious mine closure in Albania and Serbia – planned
- Study on In-depth analysis of the dynamics of coal demand in Tajikistan until 2050 planned




