## Proposal for amendments to UN Regulation No. 152 (Advanced Emergency Braking System M<sub>1</sub>-N<sub>1</sub>)

Proposed amendments are indicated in bold for new characters, and strikethrough for deleted characters

## I. Proposal

Paragraph 5.4.1.1., amend to read:

"5.4.1.1 The AEBS function shall be automatically reinstated at the initiation of each new engine start/run cycle engine start (or run cycle, as relevant).

This requirement does not apply when a new engine start/run cycle engine start (or run cycle, as relevant) is performed automatically, e.g. the operation of a stop/start system."

## II. Justification

- The interpretation of "engine start/run cycle" tabled by OICA per document GRVA-13-33
  was endorsed by GRVA at their 13<sup>th</sup> session in May 2022 (see paragraph 78 of the official
  report GRVA-13).
- 2. Paragraph 78 of the report reads: "GRVA supported the interpretation 1 referred to in that document and requested that proper attention is given to the French translation of the corresponding text in the Regulation".
- 3. Interpretation 1 reads: "new 'engine start' / 'run cycle' = AEBS shall be reinstated at each new 'engine start' or new 'run cycle', at the choice of the manufacturer".
- 4. The wording proposed in bold characters aligns the text of the regulation on that interpretation. This should be applicable to all the versions of the regulation.
- 5. A parallel document proposes amendments to UN R131 in order to keep the two regulations well aligned.

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
