National/Regional DSSAD requirements & need for harmonization



Current status & need for harmonization of DSSAD requirements

- ➤ UN R157 includes several references to additional national/regional legislation including possible legislation for technical requirements on the data availability, access and retrieval (e.g. 8.1, 8.4.1, 8.4.3.3, 8.4.5.3)
- Per the <u>request</u> of WP.29 at their 178th session (June 2019) and the <u>request</u> at their 180th session (March 2020) the IWG on EDR/DSSAD was tasked to provide information on the existing national/regional activities on DSSAD
- The IWG started drafting the document EDR-DSSAD-04-04 in January 2020, submitted an updated version as <u>GRVA-13-06</u> to GRVA in May 2022 and a further updated version during SG-DSSAD-10
- While the information in GRVA-13-06/EDR-DSSAD-04-04 are helpful for manufacturers they are not exhaustive and do not solve every open issue and question. Currently identified issues are:
 - a) Requirements of some CPs on e.g. data availability seem to be in contradiction to each other:




Fig. 1: National/regional requirements for DSSAD storage duration of different CPs

- a) Some CPs seek to store additional data elements (e.g. for location) which is not mandated by UN R157
- Industry seeks clarification & harmonized requirements (further discussions in DSSAD IWG required)
