


Electric Vehicles: Existing UNECE Data






Electric vehicles: questions about infrastructure

Motorway service locations >22 kW






Tram and Metro Statistics

Travel Surveys

- Surveys tell us **why** people travel
- Surveys tell us **who:** (gender, age, income)
- Huge country interest in WP.6 session, including from non-EU countries about best ways to improve their occasional surveys. Room for capacity building in the future.
- Possible future work: travel survey repository?



Transport Sustainable Development Goals

- Transport indicators in the SDGs global list:
 - Road safety
 - Passenger and freight volumes
 - Distance to an all-season road
 - Distance to a bus stop.
- Little stocktaking on transport SDGs since 2015. Are these indicators sufficient? What else should we track in the UNECE region?
- Which indicators does **your** country use to measure sustainable transport?
- WP.6 planning a deep-dive in 2023.




Improvements to dissemination: Dashboards & Data Stories

- Dashboards show a transport professional key indicators for a particular country
- But what about non-specialists?
- Data stories can show key patterns **and explain them** in an engaging way.
- Presenting transport information geospatially particularly useful.
