#### II. Annotations

#### 1. Adoption of the agenda

The Technical Implementation Body (further referred to as "TIB") may wish to consider and adopt the agenda of the session, as contained in document ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/5.

TIB may wish to recall that, in line with Rule 26 of its Rules of Procedure, "a quorum consisting of not less than one-fourth of the States which are contracting parties to the TIR Convention, bound by Annex 11, is required for the purpose of taking decisions". The quorum will be determined by means of a rollcall at the start of the session. The number of States which are contracting party to the TIR Convention bound by Annex 11 is seventy-five.

#### 2. Adoption of the report of the second session

# (a) Progress report on the development of the eTIR international system and the International TIR databank

TIB may wish to be informed about progress made regarding the development of the eTIR international system and the International TIR Databank (ITDB) applications.

# (b) Progress report on the connection of national customs systems to the eTIR international system

TIB may wish to be informed about progress made by customs administrations with regard to their connection to the eTIR international system, in particular any feedback relative to the conformance tests.

#### 5. eTIR conceptual, functional and technical specifications

#### (a) Version 4.3

At its second session, TIB took note of the revised version 4.3 of the eTIR specifications, as documents ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/2022/2/Rev.1-ECE/TRANS/WP30/AC.2/2022/11/Rev.1 (Introduction), ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/2022/3/Rev.1-ECE/TRANS/WP30/AC.2/2022/12/Rev.1 (eTIR concepts), ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/2022/4-ECE/TRANS/WP30/AC.2/2022/13 (eTIR functional specifications) ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/2022/5-ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/2022/14 (eTIR technical specifications). It also took note of various corrections of an editorial, consistency or logical nature that have been included in the revised documents, presented in Chapter II of Informal document TIB (2022) No.1.

TIB agreed with the minor corrections 2 to 6, contained in Chapter III of Informal document No. 1 (2022) and decided to further discuss correction 1, together with the possible need to restrict to kilograms the measurement unit of the gross weight (at consignment item level) and total gross weight (at declaration level).

TIB may wish to consider document ECE/TRANS/WP.30/AC.2/TIB/2022/16, containing the corrections presented in Informal document No. 1 (2022), as well as additional information regarding the restriction to kilograms of the measurement unit of the gross weight and total gross weight.

In order to avoid numerous revisions of the documents composing the eTIR specifications version 4.3, TIB may wish to decide when the secretariat should produce the second revision of the documents, which will include all the corrections agreed on by TIB.
