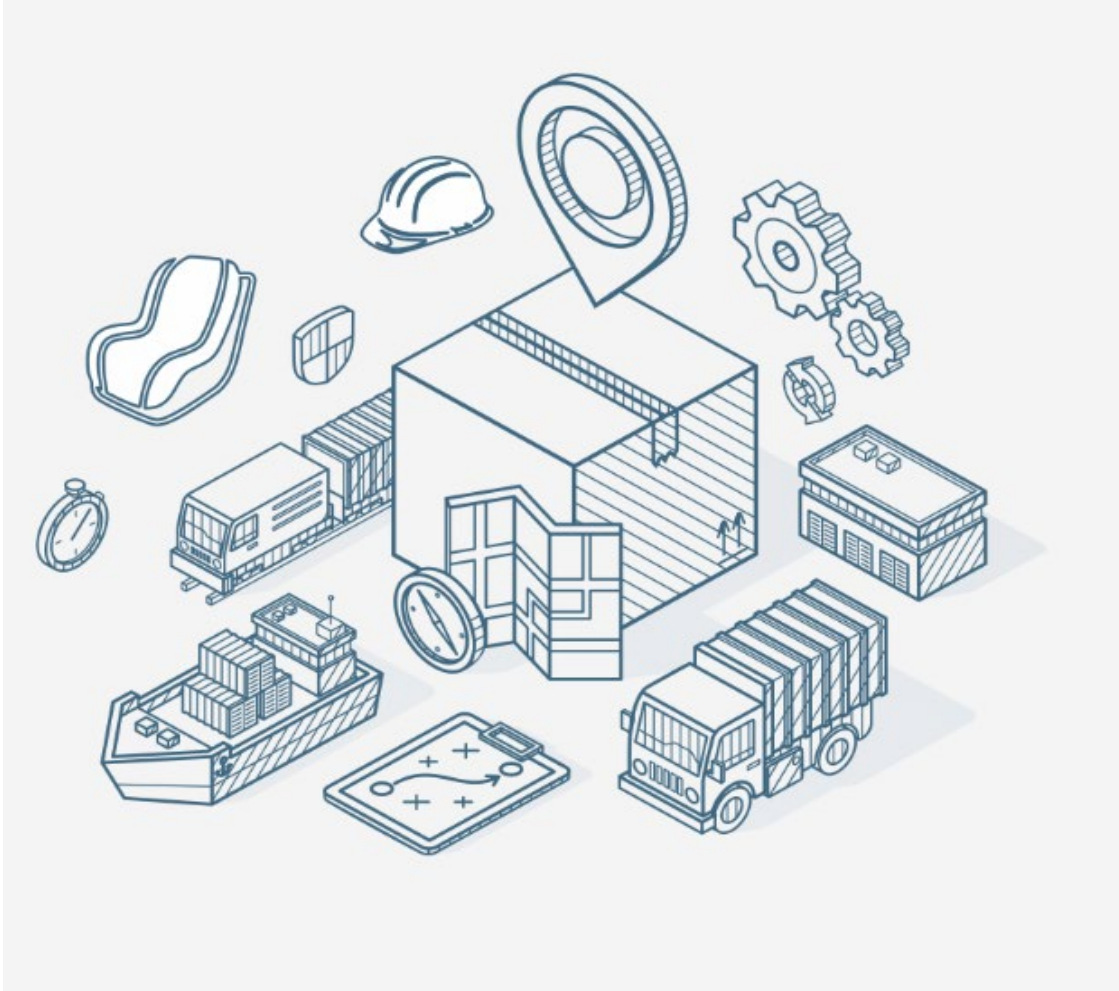

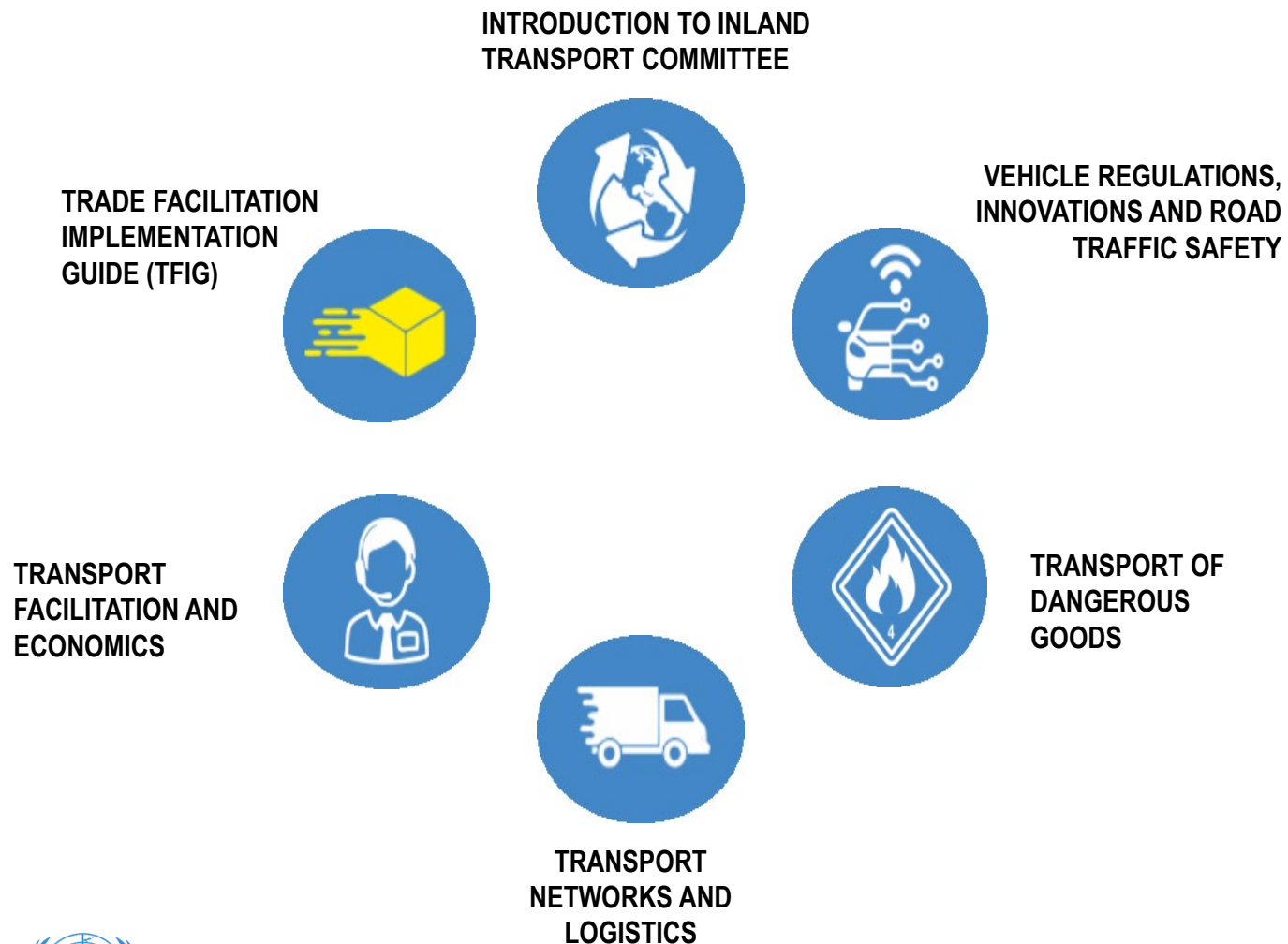
About the LearnITC platform

- How to Improve?

Environmentally Friendly and Energy Efficient Transport

More traffic can mean more emission of pollutants and CO2 and more noise and land uptake unless it is organized efficiently. Transport can thus not be developed by simply expanding infrastructure and adding vehicles. The development of transport needs to happen through making transport systems more efficient. This means that transport must consume less energy and become cleaner and quieter.

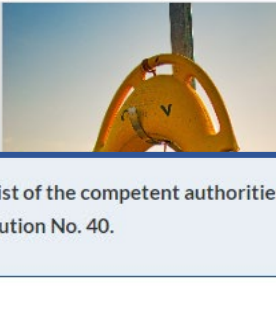
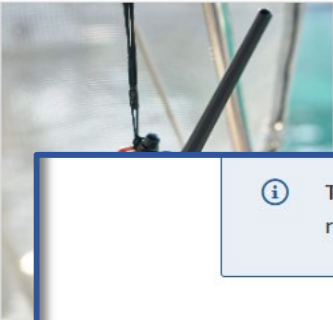
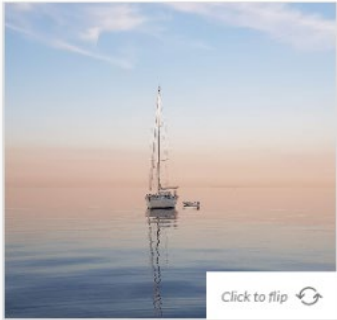

Yes; this can relate to the type of craft, its length, deadweight, or power; it may also impose additional restrictions.

Learning Takeaways

To sum up:

- Resolution No. 40 provides recommendations for a procedure for obtaining ICC and requirements for applicants;
- Governments are not required to accept a national certificate issued by the government of another country as the basis for an ICC examination is required;
- The validity of the ICC is determined by the issuing country, the country you are visiting, and the flag state of the pleasure craft;
- ICC does not replace the need to have a national certificate;
- It is unlikely that a national certificate of a country which has not accepted resolution No. 40 will be acceptable as evidence of competence for the issue of an ICC;
- Worldwide acceptance of ICC is determined by the what the certificate says it is valid for, what the flag state of the pleasure craft requires as evidence of the operators competence and what the country in which the boat is being used
