 ETSP is continuation, as from 2017 until now, of activities undertaken under EuroMed Road, Rail and Urban Transport project 2012-2016

RRU achievements



Under the EuroMed RRU project (2012 to 2016) five Partner Countries, Algeria, Israel, Jordan, Morocco and Tunisia, benefitted from awareness-raising and training worshops on ADR, involving the participation of the UNECE secretariat and IRU training experts.

A detailed road map for accession to and implementation of ADR was drafted for the specific needs of **Jordan** (2013) based on the WP.15 road map

(ADR)

Tunisia issued a new arrêté for implementation of ADR driver training provisions in domestic traffic (1/1/2017)

These activities led existing EuroMed ADR CPs (MO and TU) to seek additional support for reviewing their national legislation to bring it in line with ADR and for improving implementation, either through the EuroMed Transport Support Project (TSP) for TU, or a 30-month EU twinning project (MO/SP, project MA/44) for MO



- Analysis of the situation and comparison of national legislation vs UN Rec on TDG and ADR: Egypt, Israel, Palestine, Tunisia
- Recommendations for amending national legislation to align with ADR: Egypt, Israel, Palestine, Tunisia
- Support for accession to ADR and/or implementation: all above
- Road maps, participation to WP.15






Pending work



- Request from Lebanon for ADR training workshop: could not be organized so far due to series of unfortunate events (COVID, economic crisis)
- Request from Jordan for participation of ETSP experts in a national ADR workshop on accession to ADR (under consideration)
- Translation of ADR into Arabic
 - ➤ ADR not available in Arabic
 - ➤ Obstacle to accession and implementation by Arab States)
 - ➤ No solution found at UN level/countries
 - ➤ ETSP will provide translation of ADR 2023 (expected this November, for publication by UNECE)



Remaining challenges



- Accession to and full implementation of ADR remains the main challenge for EuroMed countries which are not yet CPs and are entitled to accede
- Bringing existing legislation applicable to domestic road transport closely in line with ADR is another important challenge
- Continue participating at the UNECE WP.15 sessions
- Only one year left to benefit from ETSP support
- Question of future updating of Arabic version of ADR need to be addressed and resolved



Possible needs for TA



- Practical implementation of ADR
- Visits to packaging/tank testing services or vehicle approval/inspection services
- Training the trainers
- Drafting of amended or new national legislation
- Continued assistance to EuroMed

- Continue supporting accession to and full implementation of the main UNECE Road Transport Agreements & encourage setting (NRTRC and Sub-committees-FP) (For ADR, request for additional support from all delegations)
- Continue efforts in ensuring the Arabic Translation of the regular updates of ADR
- Continue facilitating participations to selected UNECE intergovernmental bodies and regular meetings and cooperation with the UN SG's Special Envoy on RS
- Continue supporting EuroMed counties develop ITS National Strategies and Architectures
- Continue helping implementation national strategies and road transport reforms
- Encourage countries intersectoral cooperation (MOT, Police, Health, Other)
- Support capacity building amongst Government officials (events and study tours)
