Rationale for the National Policy Guiding Principles



- There are guidelines and tools available (about 9 guidelines and best practices)
- Conservation, afforestation, and reforestation activities have been carried out for many years, but FLR poses new challenges

Lesson learned: what is needed in addition, is an integrated approach that takes into account capacity and needs of all main stakeholders

Forest Landscape Restoration (FLR) requires effective policy frameworks to meet goals and commitments



Governance checklist – what, for whom?

- Guides policy-makers in FLR implementation based on decades of experiences in forestry and FLR
- 7 guiding principles and 8 crosscutting principles
- Tailored for Central Asia and the Caucasus (CCA) countries but globally applicable
- Available in English and Russian






Governance checklist – 7 guiding principles

Principle 3 - Development of a national FLR strategy



Criteria:

- Areas that are deforested, degraded or are prone to degradation and deforestation are identified;
- Areas with highest potential for successful FLR are prioritized;
- An assessment of human and financial capacities available for FLR is completed, highlighting strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, and threats (SWOT);
- Based on the problem tree and on the FLR related assessment, a national FLR strategy is developed for ensuring effective and sustainable FLR measures;
- Developed FLR strategy is embedded in national strategies and is clearly formalized in the national legal and administrative system.



Principle 6 - Implementation strategies for effective FLR



- Protect and restore what exists
- Restore forest landscape through planting, nature-based regeneration and other technical measures
- Greening other non-forest sectors in support of FLR:
 - Greening agriculture by alleviating drivers of forest landscape degradation resulting from agricultural practices
 - Greening infrastructures investments
 - Greening urban and peri-urban centers
