Since 2018, CIS-Stat has published data on SDG monitoring in the Commonwealth region.

Indicators:

- were determined based on the information available in the majority of countries;
- > were agreed with the national statistical offices.

In 2021, a report was prepared with the analysis of the current state and progress towards SDGs in the CIS region; the report also identified key successes and challenges in achieving SDGs.





- In most countries, road maps on statistics for SDGs were developed and adopted.
- In all countries, national SDG indicators lists were compiled, national platforms and data portals were created to monitor SDGs at the national level.
- Publications on SDGs are under preparation.
- Voluntary national reviews of progress towards SDGs were submitted to the UN.





The Monitoring is based on the List of Statistical Measures of the Overall Wealth and Quality of Life.



The list of indicators was based on international standards:

- minimum social data set
  (29th Session of the UN Statistical Commission);
- list of indicators for monitoring the sustainable development goals (47th Session of the UN Statistical Commission).

Standard of living and quality of life indicators capturing the specifics of the socio-economic development of the Commonwealth countries were included in the List.



#### **Quality of Life Standards**



The Quality of Life Standards were approved by the decision of the CIS Economic Council of 2 December 2021.

By this decision, CIS-Stat was asked to take into account information and reference materials on the implementation of the Quality of Life Standards by the CIS member states during the preparation and publication of the *Monitoring*.

Starting from 2022, the corresponding section was added to the publication, including 22 out of the 33 standards.

*The proposed standards are not prescriptive.*
