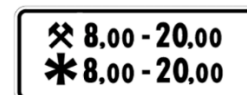
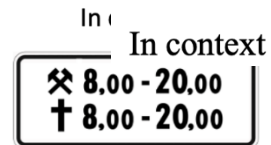
**Non-Convention signs – days of week on H panels**

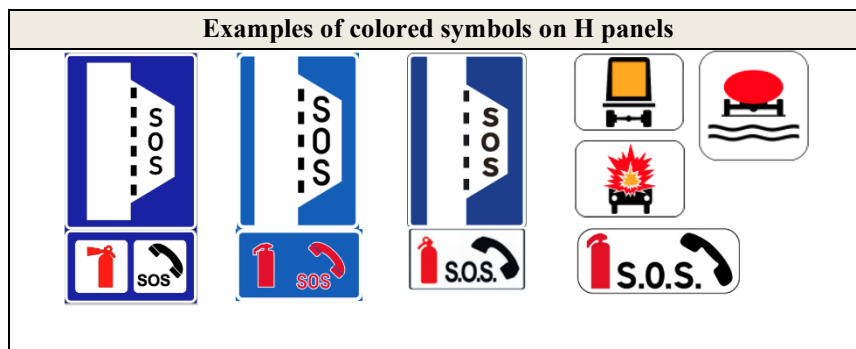
This document proposes two symbols for days of the week for Convention category H, Additional Panels. The H panels shown in rows A, F, and G are for contrast with the panels in the other rows and are not proposed for adoption in the Convention.

Recommendation to add in the Convention: CORTE's proposed symbol for work days in row B and a symbol from row C, D, or E for weekends. Religious symbols, as shown in row B, should be avoided when alternatives exist and are already in CP national sign codes. In context, the symbols in rows C, D, and E are easily comprehensible in red or black, but discriminability is stronger with red. Use of red and other colors on H panels is not rare among Europe's CPs.
