Background

- Existing **repository** of **ageing-related policy information** routinely collected through the **periodic regional reviews and appraisals** of the implementation of MIPAA/RIS
- Representing an **invaluable information source** on ageing-related policy
- However, this information is **not being recorded or aggregated in a systematic** and comparative way

= Missed opportunity

to improve the capacity of policymakers to develop policy responses to the challenges of longevity and population ageing, by providing **easy access** to examples of ageing policy across the UNECE region **through a searchable web-based database.**

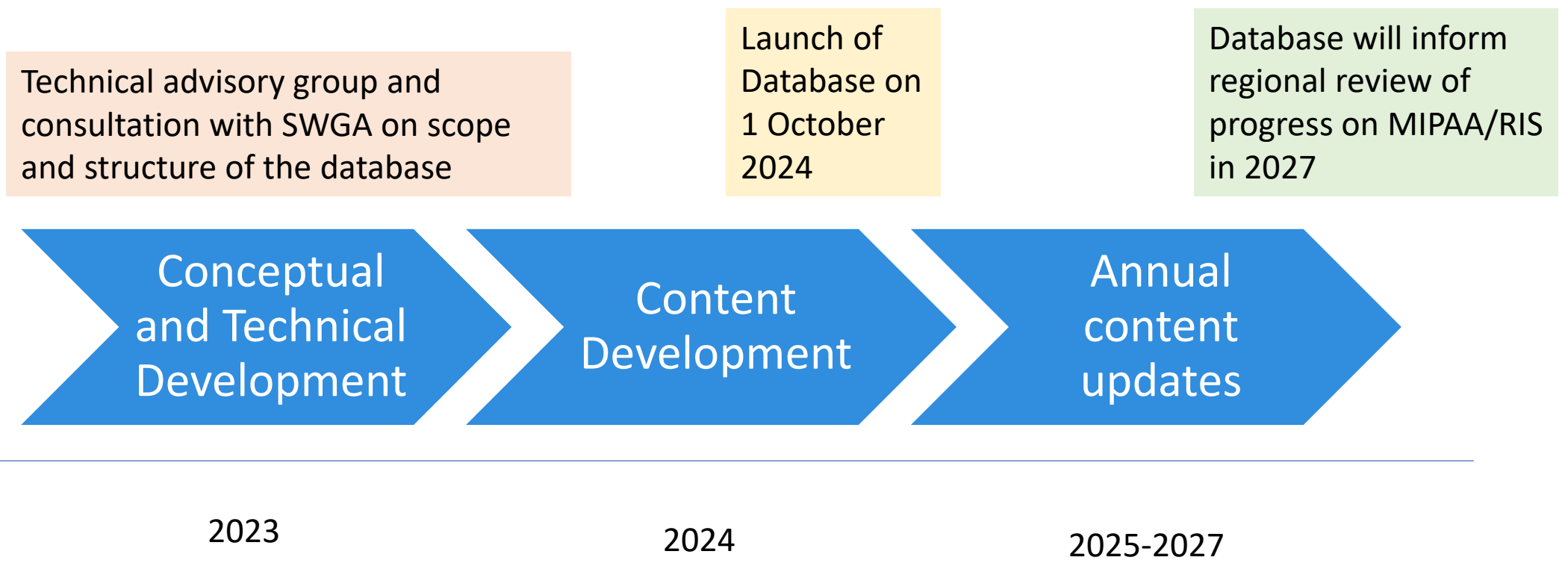
What we can gain from it

- Database will allow users to search for information by country, by policy domain and by policy instrument.
- Database will support member States in addressing the goals and objectives of the 2022 Rome Ministerial Declaration through enhanced access to information on related policy developments in the region.
- Facilitate policy monitoring over time (5th MIPAA/RIS cycle)
