### Background

The five UN Economic Commissions and UN-Habitat have been working together as ONE to support Member States and their local authorities in the implementation of the New Urban Agenda (NUA) and its three transformative commitments:

1. Leave no one behind
2. Ensure sustainable, resilient and inclusive urban economies.
3. Ensure environmental sustainability by promoting clean energy and sustainable use of land and resources.

The projects on the “Inter-regional cooperation for the implementation of the New Urban Agenda” and on “Building Urban Economic Resilience during and after COVID-19” incorporate the strategic frameworks such as urban policies, vertically integrated urban governance mechanisms, urban and territorial planning and design, and effective municipal financing frameworks, as articulated in the NUA as the means of accelerated implementation for the 2030 SDGs. Support has been aimed at strengthening capacities for urban planning and promoting urban recovery, climate resilience and smart sustainable urban development.

This session during the COP27 will allow participating member States and/or cities to provide testimonies of their experiences and share tools and experiences available for scaling up of project’s results beyond partner countries and cities.

The projects are plugged-in to a number of multistakeholder initiatives and collaboration, including the United for Smart Sustainable Cities (led by ITU, UNECE and UN-Habitat); and other global and regional networks which allow dissemination of the UN’s best practices gained at the city level.
