

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Lighting and Light-Signalling (GRE) at its eighty-seventh session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/87, para. 20). It is based on ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRE/2022/20. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their March 2023 sessions.
