Background and participants and meetings

Status on 17 January 2023

- The small group has assessed the feasibility to create a new UN Regulation dedicated to consider Uniform provisions concerning the approval of pre-cured tread materials which are used for producing retreaded tyres or the approval of retreaded tyres produced by using mould cure process with regard to their snow performance.
- The small group agreed on the feasibility to split the retread regulation and started to:
 - Draft new regulation
 - Amend existing UN Regulations 108 and 109
- The small group considered the proposals made by France, Netherlands and BIPAVER as per GRBP/2021/15 and GRBP/2021/16

Next steps

- Small group will prepare 3 Working Documents:
 - New UN Regulation: Uniform provisions concerning the approval of pre-cured tread materials which are used for producing retreaded tyres or the approval of retreaded tyres produced by using mould cure process with regard to their snow performance.
 - Amendment to UN Regulation 108
 - Amendment to UN Regulation 109
