

## **Carbon Neutrality Strategy: gaps and further needs**

- Does not signal that new framework conditions will be created in the near future
- Delayed action: minimum reduction of emissions by 2030 and subsequent reductions in relatively equal amounts over three decades: 2030-2040, 2040-2050, 2050-2060
- The suggested dynamics are not in line with Just Transition conditions with the burden shifted to future generations
- A phase-out of coal-fired power generation will continue until 2060: contradicts the least-cost path and leads to stranded assets
- Absence of sector-specific reduction targets
- Tariff policies in various industries remain the major point for debates

#### 2060 BAU scenario




## **Possible follow-up activities**


Focus on facilitating multi-stakeholder dialogue with specific focus on possible business models for industries
