- ⊖ Convention on Road Traffic 1968 (Contracting Party)
- Regional Agreement on Road Traffic (1993): Argentina, Bolivia, Brasil, Chile, Paraguay, Peru, Uruguay.
- ⊖ San Luis Protocol (1996): MERCOSUL (civil responsability on road crashes).
- Agreement on Road Transportation of Passengers and Cargo: France (French Guyana) (2016), Guyana (2005), Venezuela (1999).
- ⊖ Agreement on Reciprocal Recognition of Driving License: Italy (2017), Mozambique (2013) and Spain (2009).




Federal Law Nº 13.103/2015

- ⊖ Toxicological examination.
- ⊖ 90-day window of detection.
- ⊖ Categories C, D, E.
- ⊖ Hair sample testing.
- ⊖ Mandatory:
- issuance or renewal of driving license.
- admission or dismissal of worker.
- ⊖ Renewal every 2.5 years

Regional level















Lessons learned, challenges and opportunities

Training and capacity-building for traffic officers should be in accordance with evidence-based best practices and consider these recommendations (**Resolution A/RES/74/299/2020**):

14. *Further encourages* Member States to strengthen institutional capacity through adequate training and capacity-building with regard to road safety laws and law enforcement, vehicle safety, infrastructure improvements, public transport and post-crash care, and to collect, analyse and disseminate disaggregated data for effective and evidence-based policymaking and their implementation;

- Enforcement operations should be highly visible, highly frequent, based on qualified data analysis and widely publicized.
- ⊖ Replicate the project for other states in Brazil, Latin American and Caribbean countries, and the Portuguese speaking countries.
- O Toxicological examination: Brazilian experience as a possible reference.
- ⊖ 1979 Convention on Hours of Work and Rest Periods (Road Transport) (ILO)
