Innovative products and business models, which are profitable but also socially and environmentally responsible, are a cornerstone of the circular transition. This is doubly true for the many economies in the UNECE region (including the participating countries of the UN Special Programme for the Economies of Central Asia - SPECA) that are dependent on exports of natural resources.

An effective innovation ecosystem, where both the public and private sectors are actively involved, is critical for the development of such innovative products.

Governments and business support institutions (such as business incubators and accelerators) in the UNECE region have made progress in promoting this type of innovation, but much more needs to be done.

This session will take the format of a policy dialogue dedicated to the empowerment of start-ups, micro-, small, and medium-sized enterprises to innovate for the green and circular transition in the UNECE region.
