SEEA implementation



- > 2022 Global Assessment for Environmental-Economic Accounting and Supporting Statistics
 - 92 countries implementing SEEA
 - ⁻ 91 countries implementing SEEA Central Framework
 - 41 countries compiling SEEA Ecosystem Accounts (incl. thematic accounts)
 - Stage of implementation (SDG indicator 15.9.1): 66 countries (72%) at Stage III; 14 countries (17%) at Stage II; 12 countries (11%) at Stage I.

Mainstreaming

- Areas of focus for the Working Group on Coordination and Communication include biodiversity, circular economy, climate change, sustainable finance
- Biodiversity
 - Global Biodiversity Framework adopted at COP 15 in December 2022, including a monitoring framework
 - SEEA EA provides basis for deriving several headline indicators
 - UNSD/SEEA EA TC Indicator Working Group have prepared metadata for these indicators
 - Monitoring framework to be further developed by an Ad-hoc Technical Expert Group composed of countries and IOs engagement by SEEA community is key



Mainstreaming, continued

- Climate change—DGI 3
 - New G20 DGI includes pillar on climate change (7/14 recommendations)
 - Several climate change recommendations are based on SEEA, e.g. implementation of energy and air emission accounts, carbon footprint, government subsidies, national climate mitigation and adaptation expenditures
 - UNCEEA will assist the Inter-Agency Group and G20 countries to close these data gaps
 - Spillover effects anticipated; all countries encouraged to follow recommendations
- Participation in UNECE work on climate change
 - Participation in/contributions to annual ECE Expert Forum for Producers and Users of Climate Change-related Statistics as well as the Task Force on the Role of NSOs in Achieving Climate Objectives

Updates to statistical standards and classifications

- Technical Committee on the SEEA CF actively involved in update of the 2008 SNA
 - Collaboration agreement between Committee, AEG and ISWGNA
 - Cross-participation between members of SEEA CF TC and Task Team on Wellbeing and Sustainability
- Participation in updates of international classifications
 - ISIC, CPC, SIEC, CEF
 - COFOG revision coming up
- UNCEEA will discuss possible update of the SEEA CF at its 18th Meeting in June 2023



SEEA and Business Accounting

- Current activities include:
 - Reviewing upcoming standards/frameworks with an eye towards alignment with the SEEA
 - Collaboration with relevant initiatives and groups
 - Developing SEEA documents for the business community
- Focus for alignment is on methodologies and standards currently up for consultation/review and which will have outsized impact in the business accounting space
- Feedback provided to GRI Biodiversity Standard and multiple beta versions of the Task Force for Nature Related Financial Disclosures (UNSD also is a knowledge partner to TNFD)



Statistical Framework for Measuring the Sustainability of Tourism

- Strong interest from countries; many countries have joined pilots
- Document to be finalized this year; UNCEEA TCs to review before global consultation, which is planned for Summer 2023
- Submission to UNCEEA prior to final consideration by the UNWTO Committee on Statistics
- Presentation to UNSC foreseen in 2024
