GOALS

Improved environmental, climate and socio-economic resilience, and human health

Based on the **European Neighbourhood Instrument** (ENI) East Regional Action Programme 2020 (15 Dec 2020) and built on **EUWI+** and on **SEIS II** in 2 Components:

- 1. Strengthen governance and capacity for Integrated Water Resources Management (Water Framework Directive implementation and National Policy Dialogues): more sustainable water uses
- 2. Extend the **environmental database** for knowledge-based decision-making and the access to **open data**

Extend the scope to other key aspects: economic soundness, Covid-19, financing (incl. Team Europe Initiative)


