


THE PROCESS OF OFFICIAL ESTABLISHMENT OF INTERINSTITUTIONAL WORKING GROUPS ON TAILINGS SAFETY AND PREVENTION OF ACCIDENTAL WATER POLLUTION IN KAZAKHSTAN AND TAJIKISTAN



## **KAZAKHSTAN**

### **Process of formal establishment**

- The Industrial Safety Committee of the Ministry of Emergency Situations
- one of the competent authorities for the implementation of the Convention
- the procedure for the creation of a working group has begun in accordance with the internal regulations of the Ministry of Emergency Situations
- prepared a draft order and its provisions (tasks, functions, rights)
- sent a letter to the Minister of Emergency Situations with a proposal to create a WG
- sent letters to the relevant authorities about joining the WG
- approval of the composition of the WG
- process took about 4 months

- Chairman of the Committee for Environmental Regulation and Control of the MENR.

## **TAJIKISTAN**

### **Process of formal establishment**

- State Supervision of Safe Work in Industry and Mining Supervision Service under the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan responsible body
- letter from the UNECE (on the benefits of the WG) as a justification for the Government of the Republic of Tajikistan --> sent through the MFA
- procedures for the creation of a working group have been started in accordance with the internal regulations of the Service (request to the govenment, composition approval)
- process took about 3 month

# Challenges and lessons learned

## **Challenges:**

- Ensure interaction and involvement of responsible government agencies
- Lack of legal justification
- Lengthy approval procedures

### Lessons learned:

- Raise awareness on the work of the Working Group
- Study procedures for the formal establishment of the Working Group
- Involvement of more interested parties in the Working Group (government bodies responsible for health care, infrastructure development, and monitoring of water resources, as well as scientific institutions and public organizations)
- Hold interim working meetings to discuss progress on the implementation of the Work Plan of the Working Group
- Use the Working Group as a platform to study international best practices in the field of tailings safety and prevention of accidental water pollution
