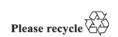

## Proposal for Supplement 4 to the 04 series of amendments to UN Regulation No. 110 (CNG and LNG vehicles)

**Submitted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions**\*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on General Safety Provisions (GRSG) at its 124<sup>th</sup> session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSG/103, para. 21). It is based on GRSG-124-32 as reproduced in annex II to the report. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their June 2023 sessions.

Insert a new paragraph 24.25bis (transitional provisions), to read:

"24.25bis.

Notwithstanding paragraphs 24.23 and 24.25, Contracting Parties applying this Regulation shall continue to accept type approvals of the vehicles, equipment or parts issued according to the preceding series of amendments to this Regulation which are not affected (all but CNG accumulators, CNG compressors, secondary engines and non-metallic parts compatible with heat exchange fluids (when applicable)) by the 04 series of amendments."
