UNECE was established to foster economic integration at the regional and subregional levels and to promote regional sustainable development. Every year, UNECE convenes **Regional Forum on Sustainable Development**

The UNECE Housing and Land Management Unit (HLMU) under the Forests, Land and Housing Division, is a secretariat to the <u>UNECE</u> <u>Committee on Urban Development</u>, Housing and Land Management.

The Committee is the only intergovernmental body addressing urban challenges in the UNECE region, serving as a forum for the exchange of best practices, and providing a platform for policy formulation and implementation.



Forum of Mayors



- To further support SDG localization, UNECE convened the First Forum of Mayors in 2020, which brought together over 40 mayors from the UNECE region.
- The <u>Second Forum of Mayors</u> took place from 4-5 April 2022. It served as a platform for the exchange of experiences on the localization of the SDGs.
- On 13 January 2023, UNECE member States decided to establish the Forum of Mayors as a subsidiary body of the CUDHLM. The <u>third Forum of Mayors</u> will be held in Geneva, from 2-3 October 2023. The forum will help foster connections between local and national actors, strengthening VLR - VNR interlinkages.

Evidence-based approaches to review SDG progress at local level - UNECE

<u>VLRs</u> have become one of the main tools for local and regional governments to monitor & report on SDG progress. VLRs are also powerful accelerators of SDG localization worldwide.

Interaction between the local and national levels is strengthened through the VLR - VNR interlinkages Since 2015, the HLMU supports SDG localization through Smart Sustainable Cities profiles based on Key Performance Indicators for Smart Sustainable Cities. The methodology uses SDG indicators & supports city review processes.

How it is done:

- Based on official data provided by national and/or municipal designated government sources
- In accordance with the KPI methodology developed by UNECE, ITU and 14 other UN agencies
- Conducted by an UNECE Independent Experts
- The process is fully open; results are publicly available
- Results in recommendations and concrete projects


