Proposed definitions

Transport and mobility are intended together in this Strategy as they are closely linked.

Transport refers mainly to the supply of transport (e.g.: public transport services, walkways, bicycle paths and parking facilities, roads and parking facilities for moto vehicles)

Mobility refers to the result of the interaction between the supply side of transport and the demand for transport, therefore why people move, how people move, when, how frequently, with what mode, how comfortable, uncomplicated, secure and safe is their journey, and how affordable it is.

Accessibility is the ease to access a destination considering the several elements that make it up: proximity to the departure point, availability of access infrastructure, availability and affordability of services, safety of the trip, security of the trip.
