Government Data Strategy and Roadmap
Seeks to create an inclusive and integrated data system that supports innovation safely.



Broaden mandate of the Government Chief Data Steward Strengthens the way data is managed across government, to achieve effectiveness, efficiency, and sustainability across the data system.



The Data Ethics Advisory Group
Seeks to maximise the opportunities and benefits from new and emerging uses of data, while responsibly managing potential risk and harms.



Centre for Data Ethics and Innovation
Provides leadership in the safe and ethical use of data and promotes public awareness and improve transparency among organisations using data and data-driven technologies.

Integrative and inclusive data system

NZ Treasury Living Standards Framework

Incorporates a wider set of factors that reflect a broad view of wellbeing including te ao Māori and Pacific perspectives as well as children's wellbeing.

Indicators Aotearoa New Zealand, Ngā Tūtohu Aotearoa

Provide data for the Sustainable Development Goals indicators and cover New Zealand's current wellbeing, future wellbeing and the impact New Zealand is having on the rest of the world.

Pacific data equity

A memorandum of understanding between Stats NZ, the Ministry for Pacific Peoples, and the Pacific Data Sovereignty Network commits to long-term work programmes that acknowledge the value of the Pacific voice in the data system. This reflects a commitment to do everything we can to capture and understand the experiences of our Pacific communities in official data and statistics.
