### Changes to the Publications Programme of the Statistical Programme 2023

### Prepared by the Secretariat

#### *Summary*

The Programme of Work of the UNECE Statistics subprogramme for 2023, including the publications programme (ECE/CES/2022/16), was adopted by the CES plenary session in June 2022. Some changes are required to the publications programme for 2023, due to the postponement of selected publications. This note presents these changes, which will make possible processing other publications, within the limits of the available resources.

The Conference is invited to review and approve the document.

## I. Background

1. The Programme of Work of the UNECE Statistics subprogramme for 2023, including the publications programme for 2023 (ECE/CES/2022/16), was adopted by the CES plenary session in June 2022 (ECE/CES/103, para. 53). Some changes to the 2023 publications programme are required, due to postponement of three publications. Adoption of these changes will make it possible to process in 2023 other publications, replacing those that are postponed.

## II. Changes to the Publications Programme 2023

2. The following three publications were included in the list of planned publications for 2023 (adopted by the CES plenary session in June 2022) and are cancelled or postponed:

- (a) UNECE Countries in Figures 2023 (cancelled);
- (b) Update of the Handbook on Measuring Quality of Employment (cancelled);
- (c) Guidelines for measuring hazardous events and disasters (postponed).

3. The following three publications will be included in the publications programme for 2023 as electronic publications, replacing those postponed:

- (a) Social cohesion: conceptualization and measurement issues;
- (b) Measuring current well-being: a review of country practices;
- (c) The role of brand management, marketing and crisis communication for Statistical Organizations.
