Brief chronology and highlights




- ✓ UNECE Transformative Innovation Network (ETIN) established in 2022 is:
 - a strategic platform and meeting place for peer learning and a joint exploration of policies and practices to promote innovative processes that increase competitiveness and accelerate a sustainable transformation in the UNECE region
- ✓ Q1 Q3 2022: Conceptualizing and launching (ToS-ICP)
- ✓ Q4 2022 Q1 2023: Internal consolidation preparing for the ETIN roll-out
- ✓ Q1 Q2 2023: Rolling out ETIN activities externally
 - > ETIN initiated events
 - Hybrid seminar: "Platforms, circular economy, and transformative innovation: aa cross-industry comparison" (3 March)
 - Virtual policy dialogues: "Path-ways to transformative innovation" (7 and 14 March)

Innovation for Sustainable Development Review of Armenia



- I4SDR of Armenia analysed the tools and mechanisms of innovation governance in Armenia
 - Two elective chapters: innovation governance and diaspora engagement for innovation
- Following a 12-month intensive research and consultation process, the report will be published on 7 June
- I4SDR of Armenia was conducted in cooperation with three ministries to create cooperation and coordination:
 - Ministry of High-tech Industry
 - Ministry of Education, Science, Culture and Sports [including its Science Committee]
 - Ministry of economy
- Successes:
 - Process contributed to better inter-ministerial coordination
 - The publication received high-level patronage and interest
 - Follow-up capacity building activities are being planned



Innovation for Sustainable Development Review Ukraine

Progress report



- Innovation will have a key role to play in the economic, environmental and social reconstruction of Ukraine
- Gov't developing a new strategy and roadmap on STI and sustainable development by end 2023
- Review will identify options for effective innovation policy making under current circumstances and
- develop MT scenario for promoting innovations to build back better

Work so far

- Desk research on
 - Impact of the war on Ukraine's innovation system
 - Studies of post-conflict reconstruction cases and the role of innovation therein
 - Mapping of innovation policy stakeholders and key international partners
 - Policy monitoring and evaluation

Goal for 2023

Provide analysis and recommendations as inputs to the Government's new strategy and roadmap

Goal for 2024

Additional research and scenario development, with additional XB funding


Activities:
