

## A new method








**2001** Traditional census

## **Highlights:**

- Only 8 countries in the EU
- Not affected by COVID pandemic
- Largest EU country> 47 million



## Requirements

- A population file that serves as the skeleton
  - ... could be police files, or health card files, or tax registers
  - ... an admin file as the skeleton for the housing census is also needed

In Spain: the Padrón

**2** Good "thematic" administrative registers


Education, migration, housing, labour...

- 3 Legal access to registers
  - 1989 Public Statistical Function law allows access
  - European census regulation





## A population file that serves as the skeleton




- Residents are obliged to register
- Benefits of enrollment: proof of residence, social services, education, public health, municipal services...
- Periodic verification of residence and expiration policies



## The census population figure



- Signs of life / signs of presence
- Starting point: the Padrón
- Evaluate the plausibility of residence looking for "traces"
- Foreign population who live in Spain but whose registration has expired
- Foreign population who no longer reside in Spain but whose registration has not expired
- It is a quality issue more than a quantity issue



#### The census variables

#### Information about each person

- Basic demographics and migration variables are obtained by directly exploiting the data and variations contained in the *Padrón*.
- But for the rest of the variables in general there is no single source with all the neccesary information.
- See paper: Level of education, economic activity status.



#### Conclusions

- A fully admin register-based census was conducted in Spain for the first time in 2021.
- The Padrón is used as the skeleton of the population and the signs of presence method is applied for the final population figure.
- Many files from many different sources and institutions are needed to construct the census variables.
- Annual population censuses and housing censuses each 3-4 years.
