- Recommendations to carry out population and housing censuses at least once between 2015 and 2024:
 - census methodology, technology and practical
 - aspects;
 - population characteristics;
 - housing characteristics.
- According to the Decree:
 - census concept approved;
 - National committee established;
 - Local committees established;
 - Programme of comprehensive activities approved.

- 3 According to the law:
 - population census is carried out at least once every 10 years;
 - non-disclosure of personal information is assured;
 - a list of census questions specified.
- 4 By the Resolution the following were approved:
 - Population census procedure;
 - Pilot census procedure;
 - Census forms;
 - Procedure of paying salaries;
 - **Roadmap**.



Issues of organizing population census and developing census methodology



Methodology

20 new methodological documents, were written, 1 statistical classifier was created.



Roadmap

A "roadmap" was developed for the census preparation and conduct and announcement of the results.



Programme

A **programme** was developed including the list of questions intended for collecting information about respondents' housing conditions and personal data during the census.



Census forms;

Census forms were developed including **5** different **forms**.



Technical specifications

Together with the cadastral agency, specifications for the **preparation of cartographic materials** were prepared.

The issues of census awareness raising work



In **2022, 148** TV shows were broadcast on central and local TV.



Radio broadcasting

In 2022,
123 radio shows were broadcast on central and local radio channels.



Articles and briefs

In 2022, 774 articles and briefs were published in newspapers and magazines.



Coverage on websites

In 2022, 2,503 articles, briefs, announcements and news were published on various official websites.



In 2022, 735 workshops and roundtables were organized in schools, universities and colleges.

Preparation processes




An official **Census Website** was developed.

International cooperation




Census date

1 - 25 November 2021 585 thousand persons

Census stations activities


Premises were allocated at schools, colleges and other administrative buildings, and the following were organized

50 census,

254 supervisory

1.277 enumeration stations.

The staff were trained as follows



Participating staff/Working days

Total: 2,160 persons

- For the work to create the list of dwellings 175 persons/30 days
- 2. Census stations 100 persons/80 days
- 3. Supervisory stations **254 persons/60 days**
- 4. Stationary enumerators 254 persons/30 days
- 5. Enumerators 1,277 persons/30 days
- Staff for entering primary data into the electronic database 100 persons/90 days

Issues encountered in pilot census processes

1

Because the census was conducted mostly on paper, registration processes were very time- and labor-consuming.

2

The work was negatively affected by the lack of separation of participants from the workplace or learning processes.

3

Maps not corresponding to the actual situation created problems for enumerators on the ground.

Key takeaways and proposals

1

Abandon the paper method, conduct the Census using **the Internet** and **tablet** devices.

2

Engage staff in the process **off-thejob or off-study**. 3

Ensure **high-quality** cartographic materials and their **correspondence to the actual situation on the ground.**

Preparatory works

1-3 August 2022 enumerators completed training





4-31 August 2022 enumerators canvassed enumeration areas





Locally, statistical bodies and mahalla activists jointly continue investigating the state of numbering of unnumbered residential premises and streets without signs in mahallas
