### Proposal for Supplement 3 to the original version of UN Regulation No. 145 (ISOFIX anchorage systems, ISOFIX top tether anchorages and i-Size)

#### Submitted by the Working Party on Passive Safety \*

The text reproduced below was adopted by the Working Party on Passive Safety (GRSP) at its seventy-third session (ECE/TRANS/WP.29/GRSP/73 para. 42). It is based on GRSP-73-25-Rev.1 as reproduced by annex XI to the report. It is submitted to the World Forum for Harmonization of Vehicle Regulations (WP.29) and to the Administrative Committee (AC.1) for consideration at their November 2023 sessions.

Paragraph 5.3.6., amend to read:

"5.3.6. Notwithstanding paragraph 5.3.1. in case of integrated "built in" child restraint system(s) the number of ISOFIX positions to be provided shall be at least two minus the number of the integrated "built in" child restraint system(s) of mass groups 0, or 0+, or 1 or of the specific vehicle built-in Enhanced Child Restraint Systems for use by children up to 105 cm height."
