


Since the last Census, the population has increased to 19,899 thousand (as of 1 July 2023)







### Population in terms of type of locality and regions









- 61.2% or 11.7 million people live in urban areas, and in rural areas live 38.8% (44% in 2009) or 7.44 million people. The increase of the urban population was about 1 million
- The most populated region is Almaty Region –
   2.15 million, the least populated is North-Kazakhstan Region with 540.7 thousand
- With the exception of cities of republican significance, the most urbanized region is Karaganda Region, where 80% of the population (over 1 million people) live in urban areas
- The most "rural" region is the Turkestan Region, where 75.7% or 1.55 million people live in rural areas
- The highest level of outflow from rural areas over the past 10 years has been observed in East Kazakhstan Region (-100.4 thousand), Kostanay Region (-100 thousand) and North Kazakhstan Region (-76.8 thousand)



- As for religion, 69% or 13 million stated that they belong to Islam, 17% or 3.3 million -Christianity, 3% – other, 11% – refused to state their religion
- The highest share of people of Islamic tradition is observed in Kyzylorda Region -96.2% of the region's population or 784 thousand, the lowest share is in Kostanay Region - 36.9% or 308 thousand

## Population by education attainment (10 years and older)

- Most population 10 years and older have secondary education 4.9 million people,
   3.8 million people have higher education
- The city of Almaty has the most people with higher education –
   404.8 thousand
- With that, the leading city as regards the share of population with higher education is Astana – 25.5%
- Turkestan Region is the leader in technical and vocational education both in terms of the number of people and in terms of the share of the population of the region - 8.9%, with the average share in the Republic of Kazakhstan equal to 6.8%

- The share of employed population has grown from 41.2% to 47.9% since 2009
- The share of self-employed people has declined over the intercensal period by 6.1 **p.p.** (from 22.5% to 16.4%)
- The highest employment is in cities, where **62,5%** are employed, or over **5.7 million** out of all employed population, while in 2009 the share of employed people in cities was 55.3% or 3.6 mln.
- Most people are employed in:
  - agriculture 1.41 million or 15% (17.9% in 2009) of the employed population
  - in wholesale and retail trade 1.35 million or 14.7% (12.9% in 2009)

- Over the intercensal period 2009-2021, the number of arrivals reduced by more than two times compared to the previous intercensal period – from 650.7 thousand down to 322.7 thousand
- In total, during the intercensal period the largest group of people who arrived from abroad were Kazakhs 228.7 thousand or 71% of the entire arriving population
- People arriving from abroad are mostly in Almaty Region (47.3 thousand) and Mangistau Region (28.7 thousand)

- For the most part, migration from the provinces of the RK is to the city of Almaty 379.4 thousand
- Almaty region is one of the leaders both in terms of the number of arrivals – 306.5 thousand, and in terms of the number of departures – 327.1 thousand
- The smallest number of people migrating within the country moved to Kyzylorda and North Kazakhstan regions 77.9 thousand and 77.1 thousand, respectively
- The capital is one of the leaders for arrivals – 298.2 thousand, with that, there are not many departures to other regions of the country – 96.5 thousand

Memory – **95.4%**.





#### Kazakhstan's gender profile according to Population Census 2021








