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


Joint efforts by United Nations Regional Commissions (ECA, ECE, ECLAC, ESCAP, ESCWA) and UNCTAD

Objectives:

- Monitor progress on trade facilitation (TF), including paperless trade and forward-looking measures toward SDGs
- >> Enable evidence-based policy-making, capacity building and tech assistance







Implementation varies widely across countries and subregions

- >> 2023 global average implementation rate at 69%
- South-East and East Asia region leading developing regions













Strong correlations exist between the implementation of trade facilitation and levels of trade costs

Significant room to cut trade costs through trade digitalization

Digital trade facilitation can reduce trade costs by 14% globally




